Fiery Gospel!

The Tenth Sunday after Pentecost

The Gospel text for this Sunday – Luke 12:49-56 – is part of the lengthy Journey narrative in Luke's Gospel. We might refer to it as Jesus' fiery Gospel because it is full of prophetic speech. In this narrative, Jesus passionately articulates the meaning of his life, his resolute journey to Jerusalem, and the nearing prospect of a violent death. Even at this point – before he enters Jerusalem – he is filled with anguish at what is to come. Yet his challenging words are meant to light a flame under us disciples, so that his peaceable, just and healing mission may move forward. How our Lord longs for the Reign of God to come in its fullness!

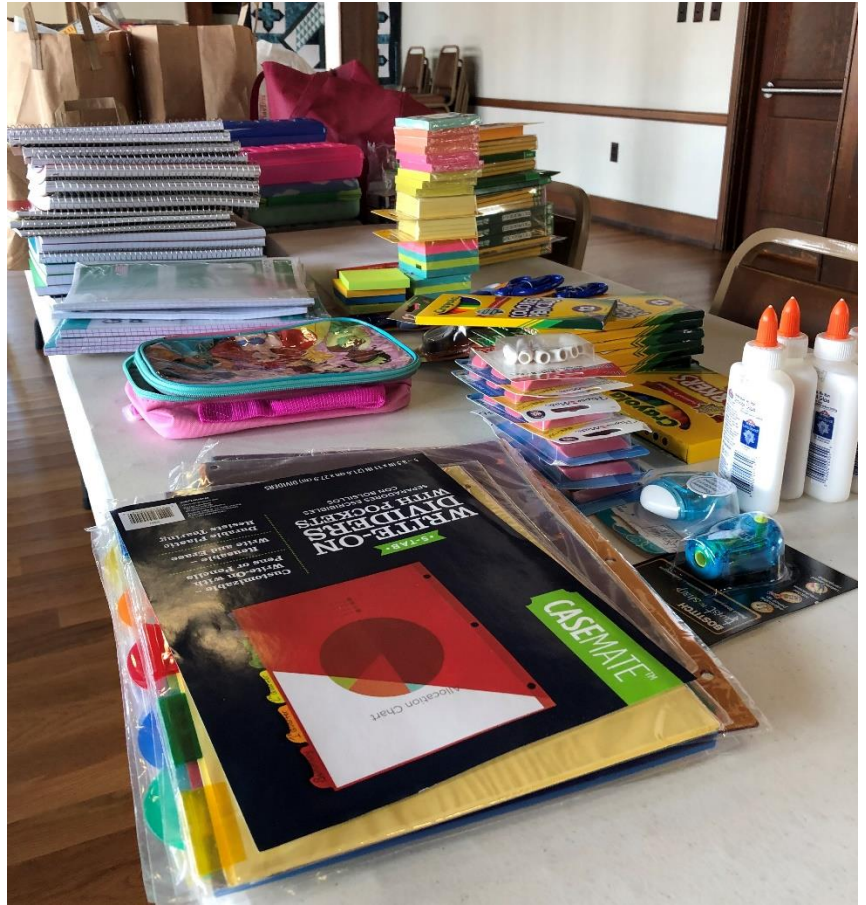

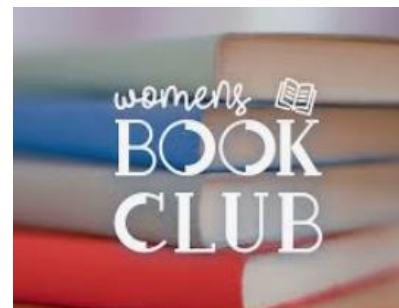

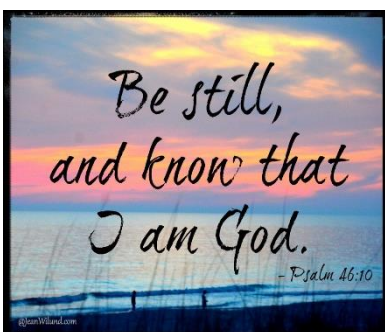
