bring one snack, or to provide several different items.

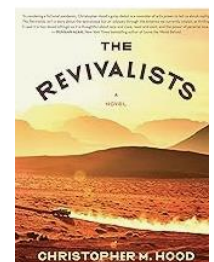


Food Bag Ministry
